





nothing but what He "Sees" the Father do,
meaning the Son is
in consistence contract with His Father and never
does anything
that is not God's Will, then, that the Father loves
the Son and
always shows the Son the things to be done and
they can expect
many more marvelous events to come?
26. Y/N Also, just as the Father raises the death
back to life, so
the Son can make alive, too, whoever He wills to
do?
27. Y/N He then says that the Father now judges no
one because
He has given all judgment to the Son because He
wants all men

to honor the Son exactly as they have the Father. Then He closes the argument with the fact that if they do not honor they do not honor the Father who sent Him? 28. Y/N Jesus' next point again begins with the phrase, "I assure you all", and says that anyone who hearing My teaching ('singular' meaning all of them about Himself and His coming Kingdom) and believes in Him (the Father) Who sent Him, will have eternal Life, and will not be judged for sin but rather has passed out of Death (because of sin) and into life (eternal with Them-Father and Son)? 29. Y/N The 3<sup>rd</sup> point again beginning with assurance from Jesus (I assure you all...) is for all them, that the time has come for them all to pay attention to God's Son and what He is saying because those that do and heed, will live? 30. Y/N Jesus explains these even clearer, saving that just as He has life in Himself, He has given to the Son, so He too has Life in Himself? 31. Y/N Also, the Father has given to the Son judgment because He is the Son of Man" (A prophesied special person ruling with God in the prophet Daniel's Book the Jews all knew)? 32. Y/N Here He reminds them that they must not be a bit surprised at this, since the Son is the Son of Man,

and some day, all in the grave (all dead folk), good (by God's standard) and

evil (by the same standard), will be resurrected; one to life in

heaven and the other to eternal condemnation?

33. Y/N Jesus confirms it is not His Judgment but what He hears and thus it will be correct because He does not seek His own but rather the heard Will of the Father Who sent Him? 34. Y/N In answer to their accusation of He being equal to God, does this series prove He has that equality? 35. Y/N \_\_\_\_ This is Jesus' closing argument as to the Son, Who clearly, He has said He is, as He now gives proof that they all know about, saying I have no need to testify of Myself? 36. Y/N Jesus uses the testimony of John the immerser, who they knew was a prophet of God and earlier is reported to have declared that Jesus was God's Son? 37. Y/N Jesus says, then, that He, though, does not need a testimony as to Who He is from any man? 38. Y/N Jesus then brings up the testimony of the Father, Who has given Him works to finish. Jesus did many incredible wonders and signs but they are all to confirm Who He is and that the Father has sent Him? 39. Y/N Professor John does not mention in his contemporary history the immersing of Jesus by John the immerser, but Dr. Luke's does (which you have covered), where a voice from heaven was heard proclaiming Jesus was God's Son and here Jesus says next that the Father has testified about Him, also Whom they (the Rulers) had never heard the voice of nor had they ever seen His form (indicating Jesus

had)?

40. Y/N To further express the testimony of the Father of Him, Jesus mentions God's Teaching (old Testament Law, Prophets and Psalms) does not abide in them (Not living by His standards and did not know them accurately) because they do not believe in the One He sent (Jesus! Who is discussed in almost every old Testament Book by the Father's writers)? 41. Y/N They search in the Scriptures (Another name for the Old Covenant), thinking they gave them eternal life, but the truth is they all testify about Jesus and these rulers refuse to come to Him so they can receive eternal life? 42. Y/N Jesus is through with His discourse presenting Who He is and now does a quick summary for them beginning with that He does not receive glory from men (only the Father), but Jesus knew these Rulers have not now or ever had love in themselves for God because He has come to them in God's Name (so, Jesus could not do the incredible things He was doing, if He was lying about Who sent Him), yet unbelievably they reject Him? 43. Y/N If anyone else shows up in his own name (lots of pious men came to them), you gladly receive them? 44. Y/N Jesus says that it is no wonder you cannot receive Me as you all are so caught up in each other and give each other great glory? 45. Y/N So it is not wonder that you cannot seek the "Glorv" from the only (real genuine, living, loving) God? 46. Y/N Professor John in recording this confrontation in the

Temple with Rulers ready to kill and did not realize that Jesus designed this event by providing a sign (#3 in John's Book) to give this well-designed speech that stopped them

47. Y/N  $\_$  The details about Who Jesus is, why He was here and

48. Y/N \_\_\_\_ Jesus' final assault on the arrogant Rulers is with the

Me, because He wrote about Me and My coming?

51. T/F\_\_\_\_ Since you all do not believe His Writings, there is no

## (And Jesus turned and left the Temple)

## 8<sup>th</sup> Thought

- 93. Y/N \_\_\_\_ So, Jesus left Jerusalem and went back to Galilee (Leaving Jerusalem in shock), to the city of Tiberias, where a giant crowd followed Him because they were amazed at the countless miraculous healings He performed with no failure's and instantly?

  94. Y/N \_\_\_ Jesus went up into the mountains with His disciples to get away from the crowds (but they followed anyway). Passover was again near?

  95. Y/N \_\_\_ The crowd was massive (5000 men alone, so
- 95. Y/N \_\_\_\_ The crowd was massive (5000 men alone, so likely with traveling families with kids maybe 10,000) and it was late in this deserted area of Galilee, so as a test of His disciples and knowing what He was about to do, Professor John gives us the 4<sup>th</sup> sign for our evaluation as to its Truth and deeper understanding as to Jesus' identity?
- 96. Y/N \_\_\_\_ "How are we going to feed this crowd Philip?" Jesus asked and continued asking where can they possibly get enough bread so these folks (who have been with Jesus all day) can eat?
- 97. Y/N \_\_\_\_ Philip being wise, and observant said "Wow, \$40 worth's of bread wouldn't feed this hoard!"?
- 98. Y/N \_\_\_\_ Andrew, wanting to show his wisdom, too says that he found a young man with 5 muffins and 2 sardines, which will not make a dent in the need for food for this crowd?
- 99. Y/N \_\_\_\_ Apparently Jesus had heard enough of the wisdom of His disciples (soon to be His Kingdom Leaders), and tells them to go have everyone sit down; they do, and He gets the 5 barley muffins (usually about the size of a small cookie) and the two sardines from the lad?
- 100. Y/N \_\_\_\_ Jesus prayed for the food and meal and began the distribution of food for roughly 10,000 hungry folks with it?
- 101. Y/N \_\_\_\_ They ate till they were no longer hungry, and Jesus sent the disciples back out to gather what they could not eat (due to being full)?
- 102. Y/N \_\_\_\_ Professor John has now revealed this 4<sup>th</sup> sign (the people were amazed) for consideration of something absolutely remarkable because with only some borrowed slight amount of peasant food, Jesus wanted to see what His trainee Leaders might do and found out quickly that they lacked any spiritual mind when it came to difficult problems because they had not yet developed

- such that they had God and their trust in Him available for any wisdom and need?
- 103. Y/N\_\_\_\_ The crowd noticed that there was no massive pile of bread or fish for such a feeding of several thousand but the disciples walked back and forth to Jesus who continued to give them though from pieces of both (which took a while to serve) in full view of everyone; and did so until everyone was full; even taking the left over bread pieces (12 baskets full), which was about 50 times the 5 original muffins?
- 104. Y/N \_\_\_\_ This is no small matter, this production of 1000s of loaves of bread and fresh fish to fill about 10,000 folk (not a small group, and it was a family crowd), done in a deserted area, by Who-Jesus?
- 105. Y/N \_\_\_\_ How did He do this, was on their minds and lips until they realized it logically had to be a miraculous sign, but of what you might ask; yet they knew dearly that it was from God and Jesus (in likeness to Moses feeding from God years before of the Jews for 40 years), thus He had to be the Prophet who comes into the world promised by God?
- 106. Y/N \_\_\_\_ Jesus know that they, since they recognized His power to create massive amounts of food, realize He would be able to provide what, when and if He desired and saw need, thus, were going to make Him their King, so He disappeared?
- 107. Y/N \_\_\_\_ Evening came and the disciples unable to find Jesus got in a boat and began to go to Capernaum (about 7 miles across the sea of Galilee from Tiberius), but a storm arose on the sea and they after several hours were only about half way. Then, they spotted something, which appeared to be walking on the waves, and scared them all; until Jesus spoke to them, saying "I Am, you must not fear!" So, they were attempting to assist Him into the boat and immediately the boat was at the landing in Capernaum's docks?
- 108. Y/N \_\_\_\_ This is Professor John's two miraculous events in one, sign #5, by having them witness Jesus walking on water and covering three miles of Lake in a boat in a second, which had to make not just an impression on them, but after realizing what has just happened, made them ask who, how and what does this mean as a sign this time to move them in the boat instantly to the dock?
- 109. Y/N \_\_\_\_ If you had been there and witnessed the man you were following feed all these folks and keep

creating more food until they all were satisfied and then 4 or 6 hours later He is walking on the waves during a storm and then because of the difficulty of getting into a pitching and tossing boat in a storm moved everything to the quiet dock area in Capernaum in a second without a word, what would you think and be thinking about this man, or is he a man?

- 110. Y/N \_\_\_\_ Then you recall that Jesus said as He came up to the boat, "I AM", and you know that is how God is reported in the Old Testament of the Jews to refer to Himself; Jesus is trying by this sign to His coming apostles, then, to raise their awareness of Whom He is so they will have deeper trust and commitment unto Him and what He is teaching? Wow! Professor John, who was on the boat, sure handled this sign quietly?
- 111. Y/N \_\_\_\_ After sun-up the next day the crowd that was fed and stayed overnight realized Jesus and His disciples were gone and since they saw one boat leave carrying His disciples without Him, they got on some other boats and sailed to Capernaum trying to locate Jesus, which they did in the city?
- 112. Y/N \_\_\_\_ They found him and asked Him when and how He arrived?
- 113. Y/N \_\_\_\_ Jesus did not answer directly but brought to their attention that the signs they had witnessed were not motivating their pursuit of Him correctly, as they only cared about the feeding and they all ought to have been coming because of more important things which should have been obvious to them?
- 114. Y/N \_\_\_\_ Things that perish like the food, must not be what they pursue but those things that will continue on to life eternal?
- 115. Y/N \_\_\_\_ The signs they saw came through the Son of man, Whom God certified as genuinely coming from Him as He was able to do such as He did for them. They proved that Jesus was He that could give them the way to have eternal life?
- 116. Y/N \_\_\_\_ So, they asked him about the works they must do God wants?
- 117. Y/N \_\_\_\_ Jesus tells them God only expects one work, which is to put their trust completely in the One Whom He has sent?
- 118. Y/N \_\_\_\_ They reasoned that Jesus ought to do what they claimed Moses had done for 40 years to their forefathers, and said for Jesus, thus, to do as Moses did; do his kind of work or a sign He would?

- 119. Y/N \_\_\_\_ They still did not discern that what they had seen and witnessed should have motivated them to abide in trust and submit to Him joyfully, so Jesus corrects them, saying Moses never gave anyone anything, God did it all, so that is where their thanks and hope ought to be; it was God who gave the bread from heaven (He fed them for 40 years).
- 120. Y/N \_\_\_\_ Jesus goes on then and says that God's bread now is the One who comes from heaven and gives life to the world?
- 121. Y/N \_\_\_\_ They recognized Jesus was the "One" that had been sent by God because they replied "Lord (or Master by acceptance of their trust), you must give us this bread always!"?
- 122. Y/N \_\_\_\_ "I AM", the bread of life!" They (This is largely the crowd He had fed earlier) need never hunger or thirst if they come to Him and believe in Him (confident enough to accept He is the One God sent and be His disciple) and so far, they did not have that kind of heart?
- 123. Y/N \_\_\_\_ These Jews by what they had heard and witnessed should have, when they heard Jesus say "I AM" made instantly the deduction that He was God in flesh as John declared in his opening remarks, but all men suspect anyone who might make such a claim?
- 124. Y/N \_\_\_\_ If they did "Come to Him", God the Father is OK'ing such commitment and Jesus will never break from those that do?
- 125. Y/N \_\_\_\_ Jesus says that He came down from heaven (He says this a lot. You ought to review and see later how frequent Jesus says so), but it was God's 'Plan' or Will as He sent Jesus (These want an earthly king and kingdom, but Their Plan is much more glorious)?
- 126. Y/N \_\_\_\_ Their's will not lose any that come to Jesus and He will guarantee they will be resurrected on the last Day?
- 127. Y/N\_\_\_\_ Jesus explains deeper that the Father's Will is that everyone that comes to Jesus and believes in Him may have eternal Life which will come when Jesus resurrects them on the last Day?
- 128. Y/N \_\_\_\_ Some of the Jewish Leaders that knew Jesus' earthly family in Nazareth though they should argue with God's Son about "Coming down from heaven", began debating with those considering Jesus' wonderful statements. They conveniently forgot His signs, as they would rather keep their power over the people and their prejudice than ask Him to explain the situation?

Y/N Jesus knows every thought and 129. conversation away from Him and about Him and rebukes them for not asking but murmuring? 130. He continues, that if the Father does not have a place in their lives and draws them to Jesus (again because He sent Him!) they will not be raised by Him? Jesus quotes the Jews prophet Isaiah and 131. says that if they have heard and learned from God, they will come to Him? Y/N Here Jesus really attempts to show He is 132. not Joseph's son and whose He is. He proves Whom He is the Son of, by stating that He is the only One that ever has seen the Father? Y/N So, if I say you have eternal life from the 133. Father, if you commit to Me, you all can be sure it is true! Is this reasonable? 134. "I AM", the bread of Life!", again is Y/N reworded to get beyond this nonsense and the fact that the Jews ancestors 1500 years ago were provided bread (manna)? 135. Y/N For 40 years by God, but still that did not stop their deaths? Y/N "This is the bread" is Jesus pointing to 136. Himself? "I AM" (Again, emphasis is on He and God's 137. Y/N like nature which will be used by Professor John multiple times in this Treatise, and if accepted, will have placed Jesus as being the Word [Who always was eternally with God], Who for now is tabernacled in flesh for special work He is to complete on Earth), the "Living" bread and eating it means everlasting life? 138. Y/N Is bread alive! No! but it does help sustain living, which Jesus as God has now become and as that living bread He will give His life so the world may live forever? 139. The Jews, as always, only heard what they could use against Him, and here suggested that He must be lying about He was going to give them His flesh to eat? Y/N Iesus, though uses their cannibal idea to 140. say that everyone must eat and drink Him, or they cannot have eternal life because if they do so, they are abiding in Him and He in them? Jesus continues by explaining again that 141. God has sent Him and He (Jesus) is alive through only the living Father, so if they eat him, they too will be made

alive through eating Iesus?

- 142. Y/N \_\_\_\_ "This" means that Jesus' description of how eternal life comes to all men is only through Him and His pending death of His flesh, which will be the proof of Who He is and this "bread" is unlike the bread their fathers ate and still died (in the 40 years in the desert about 1400 B.C) because Jesus nourishes the ones eating His "Bread" forever (no death)?
- 143. Y/N \_\_\_\_ This was taught in the synagogue in Capernaum to many of the same crowd that had been fed by Him a couple of days earlier in the desert?
- 144. Y/N \_\_\_\_\_ Because many of these had not continued to be fed by Him and because of their desire for such a leader, when they hear this difficult saying for those with little faith that HE is "I AM" (One who has never not been, as His Father was "I AM"), they being weak could not discern His Word and bought the Jewish Leaders nonsense: "He's teaching cannibalism!!"?
- 145. Y/N \_\_\_\_ Jesus, having already told them a couple of days earlier that they only wanted food, knew how they would react to such a parable?
- 146. Y/N \_\_\_\_ Jesus explains to them that if they react this way, if they were left alone as He returned to His eternal home, how would they react? Would they stay faithful long?
- 147. Y/N \_\_\_\_ Inside each man is his given spirit by God at conception which if man grows to the point of "life", he has pleased God, thus in each person who overcomes their own flesh, which provides nothing, it is not used to glorify God unless it overcomes evil?
- Jesus says His words, which He had spoken 148. to them all, are words to effect their spirits and their lives, yet due to a lack of faith in who He is (Jesus had told them 4 times who He was: I AM and 10 times in this lesson told them he had come and been sent from God's presence (His heavily throne), expressed He was the predicted "Son of man" (Daniel's revealed Son of Man) three times, and explained to them countless times in these lesson that He is the only way to eternal life and continually confirmed it all as true from God's power which Jesus demonstrated again and again). Had He not presented (He fed about 10,000 in the desert until they were all full, beginning with 2 sardines and 5 barley muffins), an undeniable proof, some of them in their spirit have had no good reason why they did not believe He is "I AM" nor His words?

- 149. Y/N \_\_\_\_ None of this surprised Jesus because He knows all things and all men, even who personal would betray Him soon?
- 150. Y/N \_\_\_\_ Every person that comes to Jesus and hears, receives confirmation in their spirit by His powerful superhuman feats which only God can do, and is drawn before Him humbly to obey His Will because God created man to be capable of choosing righteous Life- giving God's things instead of the ways of the Flesh. God has created us this way to separate man from animals and so that He should have for eternity many sons and daughters?
- 151. Y/N \_\_\_ A lot of this crowd of would be disciples (wanted His ability to be used their way, not in faith by His Standard) left for good. They had heard enough and saw He wasn't going to feed them every day, so they left?
- 152. T/F \_\_\_ Jesus turned to the 12 and asked them if they, too, would go?
- 153. Y/N Peter spoke up for them confirming that they were getting stronger: they in that week had learned a lot as Jesus was healing many people, instantaneously and every time and feeding 1000s with nothing but the fragments of a few loaves and left enough for the 12 for another week. Then, too, the trip back to Capernaum, when they were nearly killed, Jesus comes walking up on the waves and then because of the difficulty of entering a boat in rough seas, instantly (though only being about 1/2 way to Capernaum) they are at the dock or shore of the harbor and now this speech, Wow! What a week?
- 154. Y/N \_\_\_\_ So, Peter, though not the sharpest tool in the shed, is always an observer and it appears that he and likely some others now are growing because Peter not only proclaimed that Jesus was the only one on Earth that can confirm He has words explaining what and how to have eternal life. They (the 12) now strongly believed (by their experiences) Who Jesus was: the expected (by prediction by many prophets over 100s of year earlier) Holy One from God and that all these supernatural acts confirm, too, that if Jesus says He is "I AM" and the Son of Man and God's Son, there is no way He cannot be Him, as He does these things that only the Creator Himself can do?
- 155. Y/N \_\_\_\_ Jesus confirms the obvious truth about Himself and themselves, but yet, unbelievably, one of them will betray Him soon?

9<sup>th</sup> Thought 156. Just because many has lost interest because Y/N of their personal wants, Jesus, undeterred, continued to work in Galilee, knowing His enemies in Judea (the Rulers) were seeking to kill Him and that could wait for the confrontation coming soon? It is now the Fall of A.D 29 and the 157. commanded Feast of Tabernacles was soon coming. This is the Last of the annual God commanded Feast all Jewish men are to attend and it is their most enjoyable. They had this Festival with great joy and rejoicing. The Last day, called the Great day ended on a joyful note. A golden container was used to pour water at the base of the lever which they proclaimed cleansed everything for the next vears, a fresh start and all forgiven by God through the many sacrifice's God ordered them to do. Also, at dusk, the end of the Great Day, the singers broke out in song (the Halled-Psalms 115-118 were song used throughout Jerusalem and it all ended with tremendous light show which was said to be seeable after dark up to Galilee (About 70miles north) It was quite a Jewish celebration? Jesus had several ½ brothers (and sister) by 158. Mary and Joseph that lived around Nazareth and Capernaum and with the Feast of Tabernacles coming, the brother's comments to Jesus about His small following were given in a very uncomplimentary way? 159. Y/N They tell Jesus to go to the Festival and develop publicity, if He wants some; show the world? Had His brothers developed any "faith" in 160. who Jesus was? Iesus comments to them about His work 161. Y/N and their worldly view? 162. Jesus tells them, He will go but His Y/N appointed time is not now? Y/N Jesus went but secretly (as God commands 163. it and Jesus never sinned), and quietly, so as to not stir interest until He knows the time is right?

164. At the Feast, just as Jesus said, the Jewish Leader looked and hunted, which created much conversation about Him? Finally in mid-week (Festivals were all for a 165. Y/N week) when the crowd was largest and rejoicing in and around the Temple in Ierusalem, Iesus went into the Temple and began teaching? 166. Because Jesus did not attend any famous Y/N Jewish post graduate schools, those listening to this Galilean mason or carpenter were astounded as He taught at a better level than even the best Jewish professors? 167. Once again He explains His teaching is God's (Both in quality authority) and equal in likenesses? He continues saying that He sent Him and 168. anyone who has hunger for God's Way will recognize His (Jesus) are from God or not? 169. Y/N It is all a matter of whether Glory was being given by Jesus to Himself or to God and that decides if His teaching is Truth, also whether the words are righteous or not? 170. Y/N Jesus' referral to Moses Law and that these Rulers don't follow (or obey) It, means they poorly interpreted It for their goals instead of just teaching the Law and they prove that is true because they want to kill Him? 171. Y/N This was said among a large crowd (intended though, for the Rulers in it) and they proclaim that that is nonsense. Who is doing that? 172. Jesus was not wavering at all, in that, He says you all marvel at a work I do healing and then because you don't teach correctly about the Sabbath vou go crazy when I heal on It? That, Jesus says, is not good and correct judgment? Some in the crowd confirm that the Leaders do want Him dead. "They say they do, but they are allowing Him to teach (and against them too), which common sense says, they must know (understand) that Jesus is the expected Messiah (Christ in Greek)? 174. There was no doubt, by Jesus' clothing, that Y/N He was a Galilean, which was one of the 4 places the Messiah come from: to be born in Bethlehem, come out of Egypt, be a Nazarene and be sent from God, but these folks never asked Him for an explanation, that we are made aware of? 175. Y/N These folks don't appear to know the Law,

Prophets and Psalms (how Jews referred to the Old

- Testament in Jesus' time), because they then say that no one knows from where the Christ shall come, which is an error because the Old Testament tells them?
- 176. Y/N \_\_\_\_ Jesus heard this and comments that their comments are errored because you know (fact based conclusion) Me and from where I have come (it is very clear, as to where He has come from and/or Who sent Him as in many texts He tells them and you ought to mark them and to whom He told and why He kept reminding everybody)?
- 177. Y/N \_\_\_\_ Their error is they don't listen and have not used the astonishing signs (only God could ever do), as common sense answers as to Whom He was from and that those wonders He did ought to confirm, also, what He says is Truth, so Jesus concludes, they really don't know (Facts based conclusions) God?
- 178. Y/N \_\_\_\_ For the 3<sup>rd</sup> time in 3 sentences He says to them I actually, personally do know Him: I am from Him and He sent Me?
- 179. Y/N \_\_\_\_ This causes some, since He accused them of Bible error and of His equality to the Father, not to mention that He says He knew Him faces to face, to try to seize Him, but some how the crowd stopped them?
- 180. Y/N \_\_\_\_ Professor John adds, "because His hour had not yet come", meaning they would seize Him when all His planned work was accomplished a little later?
- 181. Y/N \_\_\_\_ Many in that crowd overcame their fear of the Rulers and proclaimed the belief that Jesus was the expected Christ, as His argument gave them great courage, admitting His signs cannot be discounted by anyone, they confirm to anyone with common sense- Who He is?
- 182. Y/N \_\_\_\_ The Jewish Rulers once again decide they must seize Him, but Jesus knows men, He confused them and He used a clear statement about His being sent and going back from where He came and they (the rulers and officers) will not ever go there?
- 183. Y/N \_\_\_\_ These guys did not seize Him but let Him go on, thinking He was leaving anyways, knowing the timing was poor?
- 184. Y/N \_\_\_\_\_ But on the "Great Day" of the feast (last day) after the attended pouring of the Golden Vessel in the Temple, Jesus says loudly, "If any of you thirst you must come to Me, if you do, just as the Scripture says, 'Rivers of living Water shall flow from within Him", which prove Isaiah says it's a man, not their event?

185. Professor John adds this "Living water" is the Holy Spirit Whom will be given to those that believe after Jesus is glorified? 186. This convinced many of the crowd that Jesus was the One that was expected, but still they were not sure as who and from where He came, and some wanted to seize Him for trial? 187. Y/N Those who had been sent to seize Him for the Rulers went back without doing so, because of what they heard Jesus say and the crowd becoming more convinced as to whom Jesus was? 188. The Rulers rebuked them with the thought that none of the leading Rulers were persuaded and when Nicodemus (A ruler who had met with Jesus 2 years earlier) spoke up, they rebuked him too? 189. Their argument with Him was that the Old Testament (Jews authority) never mentions the Prophet coming out of Galilee, which was not accurate, but prophecies are not all easy to understand? 190. T/F At the dusk or close of the Great day (Last day) of this Feast, they lit many, many large lights all over Jerusalem (It was said they could be seen 70+ miles away in Galilee) with the entire crowd in the Temple hushed, which is when Jesus, once again proclaim loudly, "I AM" "the Light of the world" and He only gives the light of life (eternal)? 191. The Pharisee's accused Jesus of testifying about Himself (they were correct and they actually got his point: Declaring He Himself was the only light of the world) and so, they thought, he had broken finally a commandant and must have 2 witnesses? Y/N How, after so much, could they have not 192. been wise enough to perceive that Jesus, once again, was prepared for their nonsense and in front of this monster crowd, as Jesus gives an incredible common sense argument to confirm they got this law correct and he and the Father bear witness to everything He does and says? Y/N They reach for anything, which will prove 193. once again, to bite them: "where's your father?" Jesus begins: If you all had accepted the facts you have and could see, you would know Me and My Father? 195. After Jesus' "Light" declaration and Y/N "Testimony" argument, He has moved to the steps of the

Treasure which is central in the Temple, but they cannot

seize Him again because of the crowd?

- 196. Y/N \_\_\_\_ Jesus tells them He is leaving, they cannot come where He is going and that they will die in their sin, which they decided meant Jesus was going to kill himself?
- 197. Y/N \_\_\_\_ The crowd must have been stunned and struggled at these "wise" rulers declaration and Jesus explains they (the Rulers) nature is worldly (total lack of spiritual discernment) and they act and talk, thus, just like this world, followed by giving them a chance to rethink their point by repeating the point "You all shall one day die in your sins"?
- 198. Y/N \_\_\_\_ They forgot their first question (where is your father) and ask, 'Who are you?" to which Jesus recaps it all again, I have not stopped telling you all since I began my work about 3 years ago, and I have much more to say to judge your actions and I only speak exactly what God has Me say, ever since He sent Me?
- 199. Y/N \_\_\_\_ Apparently, they are still confused as Professor John notes that they (the Rulers) did not discern that Jesus was speaking about the Father?
- 200. Y/N This is Jesus next attempt to reach these Rulers and much needs to be considered: 1) He has completely taken over this Feast; 2) 11 times He told them God the Father sent Him; 3) Announced that He is the true Giver of: Living water (the Holy Spirit, coming later) and the Light; 4) His courage to do these things in this last day monster crowd has encouraged many there to boldly announce their acceptance of His claims; 5) Before Jesus leaves the Temple this day, He will proclaim that He is the "I AM" 4 times which drives the Rulers crazy because it is the Name of Yahweh the God of the Jews which was announced to Mosses in 1440 BC and is recorded in the Law of the Hebrews (Jews), but in the Greek language it is, 'Ego Eimi'. Also, it is the way the Jews Greek Bible translated God's name, thus, to have Jesus announce and use "I AM", would allow, if the crowd would allow it, them to seize Iesus, so now for the third time(with the known" Son of Man" prophecy of their coming eternal King) they are beyond mad and almost to madness. Yet the idea of "I AM" and the "Son of Man" being 'lifted up' (a known reference to being crucified), held them back. 6) The crown really responded to Jesus's claims and He tells them that if they genuinely are persuaded, they must abide in His Teaching (Since it is 'singular' it indicates more than one Teaching, rather the complete Teaching or body of teachings). This will confirm, that they that abide in them, really are His

disciples and by doing so, they each will know (understand) the real Truth and Freedom that will be theirs? 201. Y/N The leaders heard nothing, as usual, and grabbed at being free, stating they had never been slaves because they were Abraham's off-spring (Abraham in about 2100 B.C had been given a promise from Yahweh that his clan (12 tribes of His blood) would be chosen for Yahweh's work and blessed)? Rather than go through all the times the 202. Y/N Jews had been slaves historically and why, that these ego maniac's knew, Jesus points out a much more important slavery: when you sin you are now enslaved to sin: You can never cleanse yourself of one, they just add up, thus, you are enslaved to them, which you bring in the end to God's eternal wrath, unless He forgives them because only He can? 203. Jesus says that God has empowered the Son to free folk and that's going to be the only way, as they, being enslaved, can only be freed that way? 204. Y/N Yes, Jesus says, you are Abrahams offspring, but they are trying to kill Him, which proves they are in no way like Abraham? Y/N They practice the things they hear from 205. their father, just as He does from His Father? "Our father is Abraham!", they say? 206. 207. Y/N Jesus says that if that were true, they would not be trying to kill him, as Abraham would never do this. so they are doing what their father would do? They said, we do not have 2 fathers only 208. Y/N God (forgetting Abraham)"? "If that were true, they would love Him 209. because God sent Him, and they do not believe Him.", Iesus returned? 210. Y/N Jesus continues saying that they cannot hear Him because they are just like their father the devil (the 1st fallen created angel) because they lust as he does? 211. Jesus explains that the devil, who was always a murderer, has not followed Truth and no Truth was even in him? 212. Y/N He explains that every lie he tells comes from who he is, and he is the father of all lies? 213. Y/N I always speak the Truth and you all do not believe Me because you do not believe? Jesus challenges them to give testimony of 214. one sin He has done?

- 215. Y/N So, why don't you, then, believe Me; because all who are off-spring of God hear Me and you all cannot because you are not of God?
- 216. Y/N \_\_\_\_ Not being able to deny the logic or common sense of Jesus' argument and unable to stay rational, they blunt out to the crowd that were they not correct, that Jesus is a Samaritan and had a demon! Which likely separated them more with the crowd?
- 217. Y/N \_\_\_\_ Jesus is, though, unaffected by their nonsense and says that He doesn't have a demon as He honors God in all things, but they dishonor Him (Jesus) and Jesus says He does not seek His own glory and One does seek (of all) and judges (what is Truth), speaking of the Father?
- 218. Y/N \_\_\_\_ If any man, Jesus continues, keeps my Teaching (Abides in Jesus' new Way), he will never see death?
- 219. Y/N \_\_\_\_ They say that now they know he has a demon (they were not sure earlier?) as Abraham and the Prophets of past all died and you say none will taste death (no he didn't, they again miss the point and do not ask Jesus for clarification), and they then sarcastically ask Jesus, if he is greater than them, and if so, who do you claim to be?
- 220. Y/N \_\_\_\_ Jesus explains that He cannot glorify Himself but the Father does glorify Him, who you say is your God, whom you all have no understanding of and I have always known, so if I were to say I do not know Who He is, I would be a liar, as you all have proved yourself to be, but I have never not known Him and always keep His every command?
- 221. Y/N \_\_\_\_ Your father Abraham was elated to see My day come, he understood it too and rejoined?
- 222. Y/N \_\_\_\_ They again blunted out that Jesus was not yet even 50 years old and you saw Abraham?
- 223. Y/N \_\_\_\_ Once again, establishing His eternal being, Jesus said that before Abraham was born, "I AM"?
- 224. Y/N \_\_\_\_ They finally could stand no more of this confrontment with God's Son, so they started gathering stones to stone Him, but Jesus moved through the crowd and left the Temple?

## 10<sup>th</sup> Thought

225. Professor John is not clear, if the sign of Jesus done through the next man was done as He was leaving the

Temple after the attempted stoning or if it was another day, so we can, either way, present the question the disciples asked him concerning the blindness: "Was it his sin on his parents that cursed his blindness?"? 226. Y/N Did Iesus answer them? Do they, by their question, seem to have a 227. clear understanding that physical illness is not God's judgment because of sin or everyone would be ill? 228. This blind man (from birth) was just at a place on the way out of Jerusalem where Jesus was and about to be blessed? 229. Y/N Jesus, thus, is still continuing to do the work God sent Him to do and He is the Light of the world? 230. Y/N Because of what will happen in the following report with this sign, light and blindness are the point being made by Professor John's coverage? So, Jesus approached this blind man that 231. begged on this road out of Jerusalem (because the close of the Feast of Tabernacles would have thousands going down the roads to head home until Hanukkah or later Passover to return) regularly, but this crowd leaving gave him a good opportunity for help or handouts. 232. Since he knew or had heard of Jesus, he allowed Him to apply the spit and mud compact on his eyes and command him, "You must go and wash in the pool of Siloam, too, he did not hesitate to do so? Y/N He was well known as a beggar in 233. Jerusalem, so it was shocking and amazing to see him, now with sight, as he had been blind since his birth! So, several asked him how he could now see and he said Jesus did it? 234. Y/N Some, then, knowing the Ruler would want to be made aware of this latest action by Jesus, brought him to their counsel building? Since it was Jesus who did the sign and, 235. once again, He did so on a Sabbath, they arrogantly stated Jesus was not from God? 236. The Ruler were divided about Jesus not being from God, so they asked the healed man what he thought about Jesus, to which he stated the obvious, common sense answer, "He is a Prophet!"? 237. Well, the ugly Rulers cannot let that stand, so they wanted more proof that this man had actually been born blind, than the crowd that brought him and had testified that they knew it had been so?

- 238. Y/N \_\_\_\_ So, the parents had to come and confirm he was their son and yes, he had been born blind and was blind until today as far as they knew?
- 239. Y/N \_\_\_\_ They do not want trouble with the Rulers who had made it clear around Jerusalem about their desires for Jesus and anyone that spoke for Him?
- 240. Y/N \_\_\_\_ When the parents were asked, "How does he see?", they wisely said to ask their son, he's a grown man and can speak for himself?
- 241. Y/N \_\_\_\_So not realizing how nonsensical they now looked to the crowd, they brought the man again before them and asked him to give God the glory for such a tremendous miracle, not Jesus, because we know (means: facts that lead to a proper understanding) He is a sinner?
- 242. Y/N \_\_\_\_ The healed man, then, with no hesitation, knowing he has the crowd and some of the Rulers convicted, was not willing to give in to them, and correctly says, "I do not know if Jesus is a sinner, but I do know this: "Let's just look at the facts to make a common sense judgment folks!, Just one thing: I was always blind and now I can see"?
- 243. Y/N \_\_\_\_ The Rulers continue to dig a hole for themselves saying to him, "How did he do it?", to which the man says he has nothing to add to what he has already told them, so why go over it again, "are you all considering becoming disciples of Him?"
- 244. Y/N \_\_\_\_ Well, that did it, the ugly rulers now cannot hold-off reviling him, accusing (instead of answering and asking as adults do) him of being "His" disciple (Which at this point he wasn't) and they are Moses disciples (Jesus, to almost everyone, has humiliated them every time a "Law" issue has come up in front of everyone), which by the listening crowd of the events and Jesus' discussions for 3 years with them, could not be thought to be not accurate?
- 245. Y/N \_\_\_\_ The Rulers say that they do not know where this 'man' (Jesus) is from (notice no one actually uses Jesus name due to the pressure on these arrogant men), to which, this normal courageous man fires back before this audience about that statement: "You guys are acting startled but here is what is startling: You all do not know, yet He opened my eyes! We all know that God does not hear sinners (and they claimed Jesus was one), but if you reverence God and do His Will He hears you (He's a better student of the Law than they are!)!" He continues saying that no one in the history of man has been reported to

- heal any person born blind! "If this man was not always with God, He could not have done anything like this!"?
- 246. Y/N \_\_\_\_ The, now, out of control mad rulers say, "You were born completely in sin!" (which every Jew knew from the Law, Prophets, and Psalms was not a true statement. As, man is born sinless or God sins by putting sin in His creation. He has allowed it and man chooses whom he will serve and worship. The wrath of God does and will for eternity come upon each man or woman that does not humbly and obediently submit to God's Will), which proved they are out of control, which they as the Rulers ought not to be?
- 247. Y/N \_\_\_ Their 2<sup>nd</sup> point: "Do you think you are smart enough to teach us!", was answered by the audience and the few Rulers that believed him with a collective: "He just did gentlemen! Lighten up!", but they did not and cast (meaning excommunicated him) him out of all synagogues in Jerusalem?
- 248. Y/N \_\_\_\_ Jesus found him and asked him if he believed in the Son of Man (a Jewish superman found in the prophet Daniel's Book and was interpreted as God coming among flesh by Jewish scholars) to which he answered he did not know much about him, I trust you can teach me?
- 249. Y/N \_\_\_\_ Imagine you have received this wonderful undeserved and unexpected gift from someone standing now right in front of you, would you trust him to give you the Truth, especially after such a ridiculous confrontment with what you had always held to be a ruling body of godly men, now clearly seeing what they actually were?
- 250. Y/N \_\_\_\_ A calm but piercing question by Jesus and an honest man's answer, now, from this man who has acknowledged Jesus is Lord. Jesus answers the absolute Truth: "You have seen Him and He is the One talking to you"?
- 251. Y/N \_\_\_\_ It is clear by studying this event, that this man listens intently, weighs, even under sharp pressure, then, carefully speaks clearly, honestly and even courageously, with level reason and purpose. And he trust Him because of His unimaginable display of His power, while he had decided it can only come from God. Also, He has just declared to you personally that He is the expected prophesied "Son of man"! Would you react as he did?
- 252. Y/N \_\_\_ The man confessed that he believed Jesus actually was whom He declared and proved his

- understanding of the statement due to what had confirmed His words, the sign he had received?
- 253. Y/N \_\_\_\_ This was obviously with a mixed crowd, listening quietly as the two spoke, to which now Jesus declares based on the undeniable fact of Who He is. To their question, as He is now confirmed, answers them, that He came into the world so that men can see and hear and make good common-sense decisions as this man has?
- 254. Y/N \_\_\_\_ Some of the crowd were a part of the earlier audience which were rulers and they did not question Jesus' declaration but asked if he meant the Ruler were blind, to which Jesus said that just as being blind is not sinful because of not being able to see, they, since they claim that "they see", still remain in their sin (because they deny, nonsensically, just what Jesus had declared and confirmed by His display of power?
- 255. Y/N \_\_\_ One would think this was the end of this saga, but Jesus is not like us, He takes this opportunity, having now gotten a very great advantage for many there with the healed man, by witnessing to some Rulers, are now more attentive to Jesus. All were amazed at what this sign required to accomplish. So, with Jesus declaring He was the Son of man and confirmed by His powerful miracle and words, and with the Rulers ridiculous actions, this crowd was on an intense level, thus, now He is going to feed them, which they knew (the Old law) but had never ever heard explained? (notice Jesus adds: "I AM" to this parable, also. He explains to them, Who the correct leader is.)
- 256. Y/N \_\_\_\_ Only a person who enters a sheep fold (place sheep are kept together in mass numbers for their protection until their shepherd comes to get them) though its door is actually the sheep's shepherd and any other way of getting to the sheep is by false shepherds?
- 257. Y/N \_\_\_\_ The door keeper (the guardian) only allows the shepherd in the pen of sheep?
- 258. Y/N \_\_\_\_ The shepherd calls his own sheep from the massive numbers in the sheep fold by their individual names, they hear him and he only will they follow out, knowing they can trust this voice and person as their trusted leader and savior?
- 259. Y/N \_\_\_\_ Once all his flock has come to him, he leads them wherever he wants to go and they trust his judgment, and they know his voice, having come to know him?

- 260. Y/N \_\_\_\_ Sheep will not come out to anyone else's voice. They will not follow strangers and actually will run from strangers attempting to get them?
  261. Y/N \_\_\_\_ The sheep do not recognize the voice of the strangers (even other shepherds) and do not, thus, follow them out of the sheepfold?
- 262. Y/N \_\_\_\_ With the events and statements that have been reported by professor John and Jesus continuing with this parable which Jesus started with "I assure you all", do they understand what he is telling them? Do you?
- 263. Y/N \_\_\_\_ So, because Jesus knows all men including what they are thinking, He now continues to help the crowd understand clearer because they did not relate to the evil folk, the shepherd and how sheep do things, or how it is all parallel to their situation. The Rulers are not worth following and He Himself as the Son of man, is?
- 264. Y/N \_\_\_\_ He is saying that you can be certain that "I AM", is the (only) door of (all) the sheep (You all are them), and any present or past shepherd saying he was, is a robber(false), and you sheep have rightly rejected them?
- 265. Y/N \_\_\_ Jesus explains again, "I AM" the (only) door! If anyone enters (this now new Way) through Me, he will not only be safe (in God's mind), he will find excellent pastures and, unlike these thieves, all those that confidently come through, they may have (from Me and God) a more abundant life?
- 266. Y/N \_\_\_\_ These are not all that you are to receive, Jesus continues and says "I AM" for the 3<sup>rd</sup> time in 2 minutes (It's for Emphasis to those moved by the blind man sign and are now unashamed He is declaring Who He is), the (only) good (only God is good) shepherd, who He is?
- 267. Y/N \_\_\_ And He is not a hired hand but owns the sheep and will not run and allow the sheep to be slaughtered and scattered, as the good shepherd cares greatly for his sheep?
- 268. Y/N \_\_\_\_ This last point about the good shepherd is again begun by, "I AM", emphatically saying I "know" My sheep. (This "Know" is different in that it is based upon why not what. This 'know' comes from understanding why something or someone does things). Jesus' sheep know why and He understand why they follow in full trust. Jesus and our Father understand each other, Jesus is to lay down His life for His sheep. He also has sheep that are not of this fold (meaning other folds or nations and He, too,

- will bring them in as they will (future) hear His voice. All folds will be one-fold with one shepherd (Him)?
- 269. Y/N \_\_\_\_ Jesus discusses He "laying down" His life. The Father loves Him and after "laying His life down", He will be given it back again and no one has the power to take His life, He gives it up Himself, He has that superhuman authority which the Father gave Him?
- 270. Y/N \_\_\_\_ Until about 4 or 5 months later, this was likely a little strange, because no one knew the Old Testament prophets spoke of this happening. No one knew why, which was reserved for Jesus' Kingdom to know and teach, which was arriving soon?
- 271. Y/N \_\_\_\_ SO, those in the crowd began debating what he meant, and some concluded Jesus is a demon possessed mad man. "Stop listening to Him!", was their conclusion, but others said that these words do not sound like a demon possessed man and do you honestly believe a demon possessed man can open the eyes of a man blind from birth?
- 272. Y/N \_\_\_\_ Professor John leaves this honest, well witnessed 6<sup>th</sup> sign in his history for the reader or hearer to consider. Since no one called John's history (written in and to Jesus' generation that was still living) not accurate or that it was a lie, (not one written word or report by anyone); does it seem reasonable that Jesus' enemies could only claim (no evidence has ever been supplied to support their claim), Jesus was a sorcerer, but John is producing history (contemporary) that Jesus was the unique Son of God?

- 273. Y/N Time now passes and in winter [AD 29] the newest added by the Jews special holiday (or Feast) called the Feast of Dedication (In B.C 142 the Syrians sacrificed a pig on an alter and the Jewish priest murdered the Jew agreeing to do so and the soldiers, forcing the priest to flee. The priest that killed them was Mattathias Maccabaeus, beginning thus the Maccabean Revolt (142 BC-76) which ended with the cleansing of the Jerusalem temple and began the commanded sacrifices again. Hanukkah or the Festival of Lights was established as a 8 day celebration of the long war and great Jewish victory. It is 8 days because they only had 1 day left of oil for their light at the end of the war, and it lasted 8 days and they won the battle, thus, the eight-day celebration in late November by Jews on the Jewish declared holiday. Neither God in His Law nor any prophet of God, began it, it was man's holiday. It was called 'Hanukkah', remembering the day the Temple was rededicated in 162 BC. The Jews did not reform to Gods way). In late A.D 29, it is attended by Jesus?
- 274. Y/N \_\_\_\_ As Jesus was walking along the west side of the count of the Gentiles on Solomon's Porch. (Massive porch or theater like area), the Jewish Leaders surrounded Him suddenly?
- 275. Y/N \_\_\_\_ They asked Jesus another trick question full of half -truths, "How long will you hold us in suspense? If you are the Christ, you must tell us plainly!"?
- 276. Y/N \_\_\_\_ Jesus once again takes them back saying, "I Have plainly told you all but there is no persuading you". He, a few week earlier, had said He was the "I AM", the prophesied "Son of Man", that God had "Sent Him" and He was the Shepherd the Old testament told them to

- expect to come and it was confirmed by the sign of the healed blind man, but they still rejected Him because it did not conform to what they wanted the new kingdom to be?
- 277. Y/N \_\_\_\_ To refresh the crowd on Solomon's Porch and these Rulers, Jesus says His works prove since they are all done in the Father's Name, that they testify to common sense that He is Whom He declares He is?
- 278. Y/N \_\_\_\_ Jesus then says, too, that they still reject it and why. They are not His sheep, which was the parable He taught then. He reminds them that His sheep hear Him and follow His voice?
- 279. Y/N \_\_\_ Not only do they hear and follow, they are known by Him (Jesus knows all men's minds and hearts) and He sees them following (they are convinced He is Truth) Him?
- 280. Y/N \_\_\_ The result, Jesus says, is that He gives them eternal life and they will never perish nor, can they be taken from Him by any power of man (their man-made philosophy is too weak to combat His) because God's power (testifying as to Who Jesus is) is superior?
- 281. Y/N \_\_\_\_ Jesus confronts their major error "plainly" then, by saying, "I and the Father: One We are!", which no one can misinterpret as meaning that they are equal in nature, purpose and work?
- 282. Y/N \_\_\_\_ Do the Rulers pick-up stones, then, to stone Jesus?
- 283. Y/N \_\_\_\_ As they do, unnerved by their action, Jesus ask them for which of the "good" works (only God is good) the Father has done with Jesus are they willing to stone Him?
- 284. \_\_\_ They say none of them, but His blasphemes saying that He is God's Son?
- 285. Y/N \_\_\_ Jesus answers that if He is not doing His Fathers works (only God has the power to do them) then do not believe Me, but if He is doing the Father's supernatural works and you still reject me, be persuaded by the many supernatural works themselves, so that you all may know (the facts of them being done speaks for themselves) that obviously the Father is in Me and I am in the Father?
- 286. Y/N \_\_\_\_ They decided not to stone Him there and attempted to seize Jesus, whether Jesus vanished in the crowd or miraculously disappeared is not clear, but He escaped this new height of hate for Him, as they were

willing now to accept the hate and possible anger of the Jewish crowd to accomplish their goal? Iesus leaves Ierusalem and goes to the 287. other side of the Jordon River into Perea (where the Rulers have no authority) to the area John the Immerser had done (he had been killed two years earlier) his immersing and teaching? 288. Y/N Many knew where Jesus was and came to Him and were verifying that everything John has prophesied about Jesus was accurate and they were persuaded Jesus was the Lamb of God and God's Son (which John had testified about Jesus)? 289. One of the things Professor John's contemporary history does, is to provide greater conflict with each "sign" in his Book and this 7<sup>th</sup> one in the beginning of now A.D. 30 really started a fire-storm that only produces one winner. So, professor John introduces Mary and Martha, sisters of a very ill friend (the sisters were too), Lazarus, who all lived in Bethany which was right outside Jerusalem. They all, as you can see through John's report, had a close relationship to Jesus believing He was God's Son, and was about to establish His Kingdom? 290. Y/N Lazarus was reported to be gravely ill by Martha and Mary to Jesus, who was still staying by the Jordon River, and Jesus told His disciples (Who also knew them) that Lazarus' sickness was not fatal, but was going to be used for God's glory through God's Son (Jesus) being alorified? 291. If you knew Jesus loved this family and you were aware of Jesus being sought so zealously by the Jewish Rulers, who wanted to destroy Him, you were glad Lazarus was not deathly ill, as Jesus said. You by now know that if Jesus willed to do something for Lazarus, he could do from there by the Jordon? 2 days later Jesus says to His disciples that 292. they all should return to Judea, which causes them to have a reaction: "They are determined to stone You and You are going to go back"? Y/N 293. Look carefully at Jesus' answer to their reactions and decide if, since He was the light of the world, He knew all thing, and what His purpose for being

on Earth was, and He does not make any false or erring decisions, and then, sense His tone toward them. It all means they should know such things about Him by now,

- but they still, amazingly, arrogantly question everything Jesus says, as they do other men."?
- 294. Y/N \_\_\_ Then Jesus returns to Lazarus (remember Jesus had told them Lazarus' illness was not fatal, as you read the following), and about his health, saying the he is asleep and I am going to awaken him?
- 295. Y/N \_\_\_They, still hoping to discourage Jesus from going, reply that if he is sleeping, he is improving, and all will be well for him, to which Jesus had to define 'Asleep' by informing them that Lazarus had died?
- 296. Y/N \_\_\_ We have no indication by their reaction or John saying so, that anyone came to inform them of his death, but Jesus knew it was true?
- 297. Y/N \_\_\_ With Jesus informing them of Lazarus' death, comes a statement about their actual level of believing Jesus' real status, that it is not right and needs strengthening, so they should go to him and likely die themselves?
- 298. Y/N \_\_\_ Jesus did not command them to go but suggested it and why, with which He reminded them He never takes missteps, so even in the real danger for all of them to go, as Thomas speaks to the rest of the disciples, "we should all go with Him, also, so we can die with Him.", which meant they would go to, despite the great danger and even since it seemed certain they would all be killed by the Jewish Rulers?
- 299. Y/N \_\_\_ Would you have gone with Jesus in such a situation, knowing Jesus had supernatural powers, despite much fear of the Jewish Rulers?
- 300. Y/N \_\_\_ Two more days and they arrived at Bethany where Lazarus had been in his tomb for 4 days, now, as Jews bury very quickly due to no embalming in their society?
- 301. Y/N \_\_\_ Martha and Mary had a lot of folks coming to their home in Bethany and consoling them, which means their home and property are full of folks mourning the loss of their brother, Lazarus?
- 302. Y/N \_\_\_ Martha had been told Jesus showed up and went to greet Him and said that she knew that had Jesus been their earlier, he could have healed Lazarus, so he would not have died, also, that even dead 4 days was not a problem because God will give Him anything He ask?
- 303. Y/N \_\_\_ Jesus assured Martha her brother will rise or come back to living to which she says she knows he will rise in the resurrection at the last day?

304. Y/N Jesus responds with, "I AM", the only resurrection and the only life (always means unique) and that anyone completely and correctly persuaded about who Jesus is, even though he dies, will live again, and he that believes in Him shall never die; and He ask if she believes that is true? She says yes Lord (Master of Eternity Life), 305. Y/N and then say not only does she now believe this, she came to the belief in the past and still has it: He is the promised Christ, God's Son, who has come into the world? Y/N Martha left Jesus there and went back to 306. the house and summons Mary as Jesus had asked her to do? 307. She left those consoling her to go to Jesus Y/N and fell at His feet, commenting that she knew that Jesus could have saved her brother from dying. The crowd followed her because they thought she was going to the tomb? 308. All these folk crying over Lazarus death Y/N deeply moved Jesus, so He said to the group, "Where is he?". Then, she and the crowd answered, "Come and see."; they all went to the tomb and Jesus being deeply moved and troubled, also began to cry? The crowd noticed Jesus and His tears and 309. said, "How He loved Lazarus.", but some grumbled that if He loved him so much and had healed a blind man recently in Jerusalem, why did He not prevent Lazarus death? 310. Y/N Jesus told them to leave the stone covering the entrance to the tomb in place? 311. Martha said they ought not remove the stone because by now the corpse would have a foul odor? 312. Y/N Jesus says if you (Martha) genuinely believe (In him) you will see how glorious God is? 313. T/F They did not remove the stone? Jesus prays out loud, so the crowd can hear 314. Y/N Him, thanking the Father that He has always heard Him and that this sign is so that all of them will believe that He sent Me? 315. Then Jesus shouted, "Lazarus you must Y/N come out!" Professor John, who was there said that Lazarus, who had been dead, came to the entrance of the tomb and stopped because he was bound in His burial cloth and the usual cloth napkin over his face, which obviously shocked everyone. - 327. Y/N \_\_\_\_ So now a slick plan was structured to murder Jesus, and Jesus knew it and knew what they planned, so he went to Ephraim in the desert area with His disciples for a while?
- 328. Y/N \_\_\_\_ During the 1<sup>st</sup> month of every Jewish calendar year (March or April of our American calendar) the Jews celebrate the God commanded week of Passover, in historical recalling of God removing the 12 tribes from the mighty Egypt without one fight. Moses led 3 million Jews, who just walked away into the Sinai desert and stayed as a group for 40 years as God purified them for His service. He fed them and provided water for the massive group. Then He fought for them in the promised land, so people from around the world would know He was God. Jews came to Jerusalem, usually several days early to purify themselves, for the most glorious Feast celebrating God's coming for them and leaving Egypt. They called the Feast, Passover?
- Y/N Every sign Professor John used in his Book 329. brought many new folks (mostly Jews) into contact with Jesus and His supernatural abilities. There also are many pages of actions done in or near Jerusalem. All the major confrontments with the Ruler of the Jews were in the Temple with growing crowds listening to Jesus teaching, due to His being confirmed by His signs (miraculous powers) as to Who He was and Who sent Him to Earth. Thus, on this, Jesus' 4th Passover since beginning His work in A.D 27, His last Passover, preparations are now well taught to the masses (1st century historians say 2 to 3 million usually attended from across the Earth). The question was: Will He (Jesus) show up", because the Rulers had soldiers everywhere to report, seize and kill, if necessary, Jesus, if He shows, as His last sign (Raising Lazarus) forced the Rulers hand before He established His Kingdom?
- 330. Y/N \_\_\_\_ 6 days before Passover, Jesus comes to Lazarus home in Bethany (the Jewish crowds were massive coming into Jerusalem and many, as reported in Doctor Luke's Contemporary History, were surrounding Jesus as He was healing all kinds of folks beginning in

- Jericho, as He made this last Passover week journey). He has a meal with the family of Lazarus, where Mary anointed Jesus with an expensive perfume. Judas said it should have been sold and the money parted for the poor, but Jesus told the thief to leave her alone, this is for My funeral?
- 331. Y/N \_\_\_\_ Many people during this short stay at Lazarus' home come to see, not only Jesus, but Lazarus (the chief priest had decided he too must be killed again, as Lazarus being resurrected by Jesus was causing many Jews to begin to become persuaded that Jesus was the expected Messiah of the Jews, The Jewish Rulers knew if Jesus does come, they are out of power. So, they must kill them both to assure the Jews that they by God's commanded, Rulers. Jews gave money frequently to the Temple and by purchases for sacrificed animals, not to mention what housing and money exchanging would bring in at the 5 Feast annually. This allowed the wealthy to keep power with Rome)?
- 332. Y/N Several days before Passover, as the crowd cleansed themselves, as they are required to do before they could be acceptable by their God for partaking in the Passover Feast. Literally 100s of 1000s are visiting around the Temple where Jesus, Lazarus and the Rulers are the major conversation. When they are made aware that a massive group of Jews is escorting Jesus, as He is coming into Jerusalem from Bethany, and that thousands ran out to cover that entry road with palm leaves and continual shouted out of the Psalms (Psalm 118:25-26): "Hosanna!" (in Hebrew means: "Save Now", used here as that kind of hope that these Jews saw in Jesus), blessed is He (the expected Messiah) Who comes in the Lord's Name (by Yahweh's knowledge and authority), even Israel's King" (the prophesied relative of King David that was to be King forever, unlike all other kings), which means these folks now thought Jesus was the expected Messiah and King?
- 333. Y/N \_\_\_\_ As Doctor Luke explained, so does Professor John, that Jesus riding a young unbroken colt of a donkey, also, was a sign of the humble King chosen by God to rule for Him, as prophesied in Zechariah 9:9, many years after David died?
- 334. Y/N \_\_\_\_ Jesus' disciples, though zealous for Jesus, did not seem to have much knowledge about these events, but after Jesus is glorified (resurrected), they were schooled by Jesus (and later the Holy Spirit) and

- understood the reason for all this excitement many others did understand, as Jesus, once again, stops the will of the Rulers in their tracks. You cannot kill the one being proclaimed as God's Messiah and King, using the Psalm and donkey to verify Jesus was He, unless you, at this moment have a death wish. They had to ride out this most disappointing event. The entire Jewish crowd in Jerusalem seems to have welcomed Jesus as their king with zero thought or fear of the present Rulers?
- 335. Y/N \_\_\_\_ Some of the visiting Greeks that had accepted the Jewish Faith and a living God (only Genuine God one can come to know), now wanted to visit with Jesus and asked for permission to do so by Philip and he went to Andrew to see if Jesus was available for that visit?
- 336. Y/N \_\_\_ When Jesus was informed of their request, He replied that the glorifying of the Son of man was now ready and a seed must die to bear a lot of fruit. Anyone that loves their life will lose it and anyone that hates his life in this world will receive eternal life. To serve Jesus means you must completely follow Him and anyone that serves Him, the Father will honor?
- 337. Y/N \_\_\_\_ Jesus knew all this was just bringing closer His most difficult task and moment, which was very troubling for the God-man. He realized how hard it would be, it was the major reason He came and was sent, so should He ask God to not do this that is coming and take the Kingship offered by the crowd? No, instead, with a trouble spirit needing help in this massive temptation, and after calling upon His only source of help ("Father, You must save Me from this hour!"), Jesus pleas, "Father Glorify your Name"?
- 338. Y/N \_\_\_\_ At that moment, after Jesus had made this plea, a Voice confirms what He has just again committed to do on the cross. It says, "I have glorified it (His Name) and will glorify it again." (Reference to Jesus' coming passion and resurrection and His rule forever, all of which are parts of the 'Plan' that God (the Father, the Holy Spirit, and the Word [Who at present is in Flesh as Jesus]) designed as Their 'Plan' developed in Eternity before time and any creating began)?
- 339. Y/N \_\_\_\_ The crowd heard the Voice and thought it thundered or that an angel spoke to Him, so Jesus explains that the Voice was for them, to confirm Him from God?
- 340. Y/N \_\_\_\_ Jesus also explains the reasons are profound for the confirmation: 1) The worlds Ruler (devil) will be cast out; 2) When He is lifted up from the Earth

(crucified, resurrected and coronated King of kings), He will draw all men to Himself? 341. Jesus was not signifying that His death would be by being crucifying? 342. The folks in the crowd that thought that He was the Messiah were confused, because as king, why do you say the "Son of Man" must be crucified (DIE!); this is not the "Son of Man" we expect? 343. Y/N Jesus explains that the Light, which He is, will be with them only for a little while more and they need to walk in It, so darkness will not overtake them, this means those walking in darkness do not have a clue as to where they are going. You keep your faith in the light and you will have your opportunity to be children of light? Even with all of this celebration for their 344. king and acceptance, they still did not get the need for their Messiah, not knowing the prophecies, to die. The party began to die, which presented the Rulers a shot at Jesus, so knowing this, Jesus left the Temple? (Jesus did not accept their pleas to be their king.) The many incredible signs with His 345. profound teachings did not persuade them as they faced things they did not expect, meaning they had a lack of trust and confidence even now which Isaiah the early Jewish Prophet had said would be in 53:1 ("They just don't get it.") so how could these trust Jesus also, as Isaiah said in His Book of prophesies in about 700 B.C (Their eyes blinded them so they could not see, understand and turn, that He might heal them), all of which Professor John says was because Isaiah knew about Jesus' coming glory and was telling why they did not understand it? 346. Y/N Yet many of the Rulers could not help by now to have accepted Jesus as the expected One but their faith, too, was weak because they so feared the other Rulers they would not confess that they were convicted Iesus was God's Son, because they would be, if they did, excommunicated from all synagogue's and a living? Jesus knew this and spoke out in Jerusalem 347. hoping to exhort all the believing crowd and the believing Rulers to a stronger faith in Him. So, He said again that if you do believe in Him you are expressing belief in Him who sent Him? 348. Then Jesus says He is a light, that if they Y/N accept it, they do not stay in darkness? Y/N He continues saying that if anyone hears 349. what He teaches, but does not do as He teaches or

- believes Him, He is not here to judge them, but is here to give all men a chance at eternal salvation?
- 350. Y/N \_\_\_\_\_ But, if any man does reject Him and does not trust and obey His teachings, that man (or woman) has a judge (eternal)! His Message, which He (only) spoke to them, It will be their judge in the last Day, which is when it is appointed by God that all mankind that has ever lived will be judged, determining where they spend eternity?
- 351. Y/N \_\_\_\_ Nothing, Jesus says, that He spoke, was from Him alone, but all of it came from the One God Himself: All Jesus said (Equal to God) and spoke (came by God)?
- 352. Y/N \_\_\_\_ And Jesus confirms that God's Commandment (which is everything He [Jesus] did or said) is for eternal life to those that respond, turn and reform, because they, then, are in compliance to God's Will?
- 353. Y/N \_\_\_\_ And then, in this final thought for these weak believers to remember, as they rethink their lack of a necessary level of belief, it is that Jesus is the only one that has ever existed, face to face, with the Father! That is the most important motivation they, or anyone, must have if they are going to be completely persuaded to follow Jesus?
- 354. Y/N \_\_\_\_ This final thought by Jesus to the crowd, Rulers and disciples, about what should be their correct motivation for commitment to Him, ends professor John's presentation of the public ministry of Jesus, right before the 4<sup>th</sup> Passover, A.D 30. God planned from eternity for Him to do these revealed works and words. This next part of His Book is a private session with only His 12 to be Apostles at the last Passover ever to be accepted as a commanded Feast of Yahweh, the Jews God?

### 12<sup>th</sup> Thought

Special Preparations for the Coming Kingdom and Its New Covenant (Eternal)

Jewish Passover always begins at sundown Friday night. There, too, is a day of preparation. This is the Jews most special historical holiday. How do 3 million Jewish slaves leave Egypt (the most powerful country and army in the known world at that time) after over 400 years of being peacefully under Egypt's whip and never revolt before?

When they left, the Jews had no army and did not fight, they just left which staggered Egypt. The story of significant historical importance is reported by the Jewish Leader, Moses. He was raised, educated and trained Egyptian, but lead the Jews for 40 years in the "Wilderness", not to challenge the other surrounding countries, well established north of Egypt. How they left Egypt and lived, supporting 3 million Jews for 40 years in the wilderness, not aggressive and by Jews ways: Yahweh (their God) did it all to fulfill a covenant with the Jews for Father, Abraham. The fact that it took place is historically undeniable; with the collapse of Egypt's power undeniable, where the Jews disappeared from Egypt to exist with 3 million people (12 tribes of Jacob: Abraham grandson, being lead by Moses as Leader, nonaggressive for 40 years) is guite a historical story, provable by their finally move to Canaan and overtaking their kingdom. Canaan had become such a horrid, vile, ungodly in every way kingdom, Yahweh slaughtered them and displaced them with His chosen tribes. The Passover Festival is in memorial to that exit. The initial requirements were part of Yahweh's last chance lesson (Moses had produced it by Yahweh in 10 superhuman lessons, with provided prior warning by Moses to the Pharaoh of Egypt of each coming lesson. They did not have it happen, if you (Egypt) "Allow My people to leave to serve Me." He was told he may call upon his gods, whom Yahweh was attacking or let my people! (Israel-Jews) go worship and serve me. Pharaoh toyed with Moses, increased penalties upon the Jewish slaves, which went on until the 10<sup>th</sup> event. After the 10<sup>th</sup> supernatural attack of Egypt's God of Life and 1st born, he let the Jews go. The Jews were required by Yahweh to kill a lamb on a particular day, particular kind, eat a particular way, and put the blood on the doorway of their homes so the death of all 1st born (even among the Jews ) could be 'passed over' that night. Most Jews, realizing that none of the previous 9 events had touched any Jew, only Egyptians, believed, so most of them did as instructed and of course, since Pharaoh was the Egyptian god's representative among Egyptians, they senselessly all lost their 1st born and proved that Yahweh was the living God and Pharaoh's was a lie. So, one can see that this historical sequence of events, which few deny, actually took place, and Yahweh established His annual memorial to that exact day and events to be a kind of important, if not essential, reminder to mankind, as they through the years come to an understanding of these happenings in history. They would provide man a credible historical view as to His power, goals, care and kindness; and demand for common sense over arrogance, if one or a million turn to Him and give Him honor reverence and obedience. To not do so is Passover's reminder of just how stupid such a life is, God is watching and evaluating. Thus, on Passover some 1500 years after it actually took place, where Jews are required (every male) to come worship Yahweh in Jerusalem (said to

have 2.5 million there at all 3 commanded Feast) His way. They still were only allowed (Jews and new believers of the mono-theistic God) to give Him worship (as well as daily service year-round) as He would accept it. Jesus being, as Professor John has declared in his opening statement of this treatise, a part of the Godhead (Who now, temporarily, has taking on flesh), being sent to Earth on a mission of God's ultimate 'Plan' for His creation and a sinless Jew. came to all commanded Feast. This Passover was of special monumental importance: 1) It was Jesus' finally Jewish Feast upon Earth; 2) Passover would never again be anything more than a national holiday of Jews; 3) Jesus was to become the actual, genuine sacrificial lamb of God and the Jews. Though until now, the old way was accepted by Yahweh, (if done properly and from their hearts), it was accepted by Him no longer. It actually is about to become only a "Type" of the, now, genuine sacrifice of God's lamb for all mankind and not just folk following Moses' Law. They had fulfilled their part of His mission for mankind's salvation. Thus, Jesus was very knowledgeable of what was about to happen this year. In less than 24 hours His 3 ½ year mission was completed. He had, still, though, several things to accomplish to satisfy all God's work to be finished. The next few thoughts will be "Only" with His chosen 12 Apostles (Judas will leave early) and give them some special insight as to what is happening, why, what to expect of them and the results that they will be a part of. It is a special time for them. They will not understand or appreciate it, until it is all done, over the next 50 to 60 days). Read this entire personal time with these men and Jesus, until Jesus is apprehended in the Garden, ok? Then answer and study questions.

- 1. Y/N \_\_\_\_ The time of the Passover meal was set. The meal prepared. All the 12 were with Jesus. He knew them well after 3 ½ years and knows none of them actually are as spiritually sound as He could have hoped they would be. He was, in the less than 24 hours He had left, going to have accomplished all and exactly what He came to do, by God's constant interaction. He would leave the next phase in their hands. He loved them and loved them enough to trust them with His coming Kingdom. His love for His creation motivated Him to finish His work?
- 2. Y/N \_\_\_\_ The group reclined around the prepared table to eat the Passover meal. Jesus rises from the table, ever knowing the ending fulfillments of what Messiah is to do to provide His group that will give Him Kingship over all things: seeable example, power over heavens and earth, authority beyond man's capability or even wisdom to comprehend. So, He removes His outer clothing, took a towel and wrapping it around Himself, poured water into a bowl, kneed down and one by one around

the table, He washed their feet (including Judas Iscariot, the coming traitor)? No comments are made as Jesus does what every Jewish home provides their guest usually by the youngest child or a servant, until He get to Peter? Peter has clearly learned that Jesus is God's Son through the course of 3 ½ years of interaction and is shocked as he says "Lord!" You are about to wash my feet?" Knowing this is not right, you are our Lord not we yours? \_ Jesus says exactly what Peter still needed to hear, saying, "You do not realize what I am doing but later you will.". To which Peter displays his still lack of knowing what "Lord" actually means by saying that Jesus" will never wash his feet!" in a defiant declaration. Did he not just call Jesus 'Lord'? Jesus makes it clear that his defiant stance is a matter 6. Y/N of eternity, because no matter your defiance, if I, your Lord, Who expects your submission to My Will (you do it as Jesus says Peter you must) do not allow it, you will be cast out of My (Jesus') group? 7. Y/N Peter says for Jesus, his Lord, to completely wash me, still displaying some arrogance, instead of humbly allowing His Lord to teach whatever lesson He knows they all still need? 8. Y/N Iesus says to Peter that he in Iesus eyes, though not perfect, is fully clean already and needs only to allow his "Lord" to clean his feet? 9. Y/N Jesus continues through the 12, saying they are all just a clean as Peter, but not everyone is right, because Jesus was fully aware of Judas Iscariot's intentions and his deal with the Jewish Leaders. So, "Not everyone" was referring to him, whom Iesus had just washed the feet of? After Jesus finished and dressed, He reclined again with them around the Feast meal (The Passover meal has several servings of wine and foods and includes quotes of the Law) without mentioning again the betrayer, as the lesson was far more important; saying "Do you understand what I have done to you all?" Do you think they understood? They are reminded by Jesus that they correctly address Him as Teacher (Supreme) and Lord (their Master). He is? 12. So, if Jesus by example of humility does anything, it is imperative that they overcome their self-pride, arrogance, or being "puffed up" (Sense of better than others, all of which they still possessed), by doing exactly what their Lord has displayed, which was humility and desire deeply to serve one another (love conquers all man's mistakes)?

Y/N Jesus reinforces the essential point of the lesson 13. to his 12 by saying, "Truly, Truly I assure you (meaning this is of major importance, depend upon me, I am giving you indispensable Truth)"? 14. Y/N Jesus' summary of the lesson is about humility, about that, which these 12 must have to actively treat each other as family, and as if Jesus has sent them all as one? 15. Their reform, love, and humility toward each Y/N other is to be just as the Father and Jesus have; Who sent Him and is expecting it to be maintained? 16. As the meal continues, Jesus obviously is realizing how close is the end of His time. He has among these men and that Judas is about to leave. He spoke out that one of them was about to betray Him! Each of the disciples was shocked and wondering who it could be. Peter mentioned to John, who reclined right next to Jesus, to ask Jesus who it was, and Jesus told him who by His giving a dipped piece of bread, so he would know? 17. Y/N Jesus handed it to Judas, who had already conspired with the Jewish Leaders to capture Jesus when the crowds were not around, and Judas realized that the Garden on Olives Mount would be best, and he needed to leave the meal to set it up. Jesus then said, "Go immediately and do what you must do." None of the other Apostles concluded that Jesus was talking about the coming betrayed by Judas? 18. Judas left before the meal was completed and Y/N Jesus made a declaration, saying that, now, quickly Jesus' glory and God's glory would be fulfilled. The idea that this prophesied betrayal could lead to their being glorified, is because their glory is not like mankind's idea of glory. God's and His Son's is about to be one of the climatic eternal parts of the 'Plan' they only could have developed in eternity before any created person was given life, time and choice. This glory was now involving Judas' betraying Jesus, which will bring to a close the great, glorious result only Jesus, the Father and the Holy Spirit, at this point, understood? 19. Jesus does not explain the glory coming but says that He will not be with them (now the 11) much longer and they cannot go where He is going? Jesus re-emphasized His towel instruction more 20. directly, as He is leaving them. So, He is stressing that each of them must completely love and trust and sacrifice for each other, identically as He has loved them. 

There is still preparation for those who are to be in God's house and only I can make all thing ready. When I return all will be completed and I, then, will receive you all to Myself so you can be there with Me? 29. Y/N You all actually do know the way to where I go? Do they? 30. Thomas disagrees because he says, you only are going, so how can we have the facts about the way to get there? Was he correct? 31. Jesus tries again to take these 11 Apostles to Y/N what should be obvious to them. He says, "I AM", the only Way, the only Truth and the only Life", which by this time or stage of their discipleship ought to be clear? 32. And no one can come to the Father accept Y/N through Him (Jesus)? This is most interesting because the 2 kinds of 33. "Know" are used by Jesus (coming to understand things by serious, correct evaluation and facts that lead to correct

knowledge), so Jesus says if they have correctly understood who Jesus is, the facts produce knowledge of knowing the Father. The verbs (know-both kinds) are pluperfects, which are difficult to translate into English. By having observed Jesus over the course of 3 ½ years, each of His many signs and teachings, when they are considered, produce knowledge that He is Whom He claims to be, which still, among these have not come to discern what they were designed to produce: He is the Son of God and sent by the Father to effect understanding and knowledge. Should they have discerned by then, that Jesus is God, from God and what God was like in His nature?

- 36. Y/n \_\_\_\_ Jesus reemphasizes the fact that He and the Father have to be one or the signs and words of Jesus about the coming New Covenant and Kingdom, as well as, Who He was would differ in some way, which the signs confirm they do not differ?
- 37. Y/N \_\_\_\_ Jesus relates a new coming thing that will happen to them, if they discern these things, in that they themselves will do greater works than Jesus has, as Jesus will soon go back to join the Father in heaven?
- 38. Y/N \_\_\_\_ If you all (actually each of you) require signs and teachings to work in My Name that glorify the Father (not yourself or your pride), I will provide you the power to do them and nothing will be denied you; if this is the purpose and in My Name?

the world will never see Me on Earth again, but you all (Apostles that were there and some other few 100s of true believers)?  44. Y/N Jesus notes that He will live again and forever and so they too, will live eternally which they did not understand at this time?


- 65. Y/N \_\_\_\_ Does Jesus proclaim to them that He is the only correct and accurate Vine of God?
- 66. Y/N \_\_\_\_ Does Jesus then follow that declaration with the fact the Father (unmistakable by their knowledge and understanding by now) is the only correct, accurate and powerful Vine-dresser?

Y/N Would the Apostle's (11) attention, once again, 67. be given to what Jesus is to say by this "I AM" opening, even if they did not vet fully understand? 68. The Father has total authority, insuring that every branch (themselves) does bear fruit and sees to the pruning (expert Vine-dresser) such that they can bear maximum fruit? 69. They, Jesus explains, are His branches which Y/N have already received a 1st pruning by being subjected and involved with Jesus work, which they have witnessed, and have heard spoken to and about them, so far? 70. Y/N They cannot produce correct fruit (by the Father's expert examination) as they must abide in Him and He in them to do so? 71. No branch has the right to produce fruit of its Y/N own or as it desires, it must remain in the vine and so they all (11 apostles) can only produce correctly if they abide in Jesus' new Way? 72. Y/N Again, Jesus says, "I AM, the only vine" and they are branches (with emphasis), yet they have to make a choice to abide in Him or not. If they do not remain in Him and He in them, they produce nothing correct (the Father's standard)? 73. Abiding in Jesus (His way) is the key they have to submit to be and proclaim or the penalty is clear: Any one of them who does not so abide will be cut-off as a bad branch (by the Vine-Keeper), will with others, receive no nourishment from the Vine, be gathered (angel's job on the Last Day), thrown into the fire (already prepared for Fallen angels by God's wrath for their bad choice) and burned (not burned-up or annihilatedburned!)? 74. So, with the absolute imperative need for these 11 Galilean men to be mimics of Jesus' every word, they abiding themselves in only those Teachings have to be, also, remaining in them and will, as long as each of them remains in Jesus? 75. - 81. Y/N \_\_\_\_ Jesus love for them is not at this point completely understandable, so they might have viewed "Love" at a slightly lesser level than "One Another? It is raised above the usual Jewish ideas of one another and affection's results, because their Jewish Leader declared God has said it in the Old Law. They by pride and arrogance lived in hate for many, even killing each other in God's Name. Thus, Jesus saying the "Greater" love is complete willingness to give your life for a friend (Jesus has exposed that a neighbor is your friend in His teaching)?

"Glorify" can mean different things but here is always means the highest exultation that can be given. You cannot, truly, imagine the exultation received and given to each other of the two most vivid persons of the Godhead, talking and considering only each other at this point. - 140.Y/N  $\_$  This  $2^{nd}$  incredible given superpower is the ability to give actual eternal life to everyone that receives Jesus as God's Son?
- 141.Y/N \_\_\_\_ Eternal life is given by Them to those who properly come to understand that God is (always will and has been) the only God and Jesus (their) Christ, Whom the Father sent (on a unique mission), for the souls of mankind?
- 142.Y/N \_\_\_\_ As you review the 3 ½ year work Professor John has provided as a contemporary history, Jesus' words here, saying He has from the beginning of that work to now, exulted the Father in all He said and did?


